The revised Immigration Control and Refugee Recognition Act will come into effect from July 9th, 2012. Major changes include a new residency management system, following the implementation of a points-based system which has just been introduced on May 7. As these changes will affect every foreign resident, the speakers will elaborate the main points and discuss how these changes are going to apply to your business and daily life.

- New! Points-based system for Highly Skilled Professionals with preferential treatments
- New procedures at Immigration Bureaus and local government offices
- Re-entry permit without filing an application
- Resident ("zairyu") card
- "5 years" period of stay
- Obligation to report changes to the authorities
